Journalists and Photographers from Poland and outside of Europe apply for accreditation individually using Public Forms




The are <u>two seperate</u> Public Forms:

- → for Journalists (Press/Radio)
- → for Photographers (Photo) ●

Media Accreditation Key Dates

DATE	ACTION	
by 7 th April	→ Start of the Media Accreditation Process	
by 15 th April	→ Media Accreditation Manual with the link to the Public Forms is to be sent to the media	
15 th May	→ Deadline for submitting accreditation applications via Public Forms	
by 31st May	→ A decision to accept or reject the application for accreditation is to be made	
after 5 th June		
(As per Accreditation Centres operational period)	→ Start of Accreditation distribution at the Accreditation Centres – personal collection	



Data scope for Accreditation

- Given name, Family name
- Date of birth
- Gender
- Nationality
- ID/Passport Number (issue date, expiry date, country of issue)
- PESEL* (Polish citizens only)
- Organization/Title
 - Estimated reach of readers/audience
- Email address
- Phone number
- Disability* (if applicable)
